#### **Item II The Companies (Alderney) Law 1994 Fees Ordinance 2011**

**Item IV The Fees (Alderney) Law 2011**

The States resolved to approve the Projet de Loi entitled The Fees (Alderney) Law 2011 and to request the President to seek the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council for it to have the force of Law in the island of Alderney.

**Item V The Alderney Potable Water Project Phase 3**

The States resolved to approve to acquire by purchase:

- (a) all that freehold property registered under title AY1482 (Parcel 178 S.1, LAie, La Grande Blaye) in the Alderney Land Registry; and
- (b) all that freehold property registered under title AY1486 (Parcel 81 S.1, LAie, La Grande Blaye) in the Alderney Land Registry; and
- (c) to serve notice on the respective owners of the land pursuant to and in accordance with section 1(2) of The Compulsory Purchase (Alderney) Law, 1986.
